ADVOCACY EFFORTS AT THE STATE AND FEDERAL LEVEL TO PROMOTE NONDISCRIMINATION MORE BROADLY IN THE CHILD WELFARE AND JUVENILE JUSTICE SYSTEM. FOR EXAMPLE, WE FILED AN AMICUS BRIEF IN THE U.S. SUPREME COURT ON BEHALF OF CHILD WELFARE AGENCIES, EXPLAINING THE SERIOUS HARM TO LGBTO AND OTHER CHILDREN IN FOSTER CARE SYSTEMS THAT RESULTS FROM ALLOWING TAXPAYER-FUNDED ORGANIZATIONS TO DISCRIMINATE AGAINST SAME-SEX COUPLES WISHING TO SERVE AS FOSTER OR ADOPTIVE PARENTS. LIKEWISE, WE HAVE REPRESENTED LGBTO YOUTH SEEKING TO PARTICIPATE IN CASES WHERE PUBLIC SCHOOLS HAVE BEEN SUED FOR DISCIPLINING TEACHERS DEMANDING THE RIGHT TO MISGENDER THEIR STUDENTS AS AN EXERCISE OF RELIGIOUS LIBERTY OR FREE SPEECH. WE ALSO FILED

AMICUS BRIEFS IN THE U.S. SUPREME COURT AND IN OTHER FEDERAL AND STATE COURTS OF APPEALS TO ENSURE THAT THE GOVERNMENT'S COMPELLING INTEREST IN COMBATTING ANTI-LGBTO DISCRIMINATION IS GIVEN DUE CONSIDERATION AND WEIGHT IN CASES SEEKING TO UNDERMINE OR DILUTE SUCH PROTECTIONS. WITH THE BENEFIT OF THIS RULING, WE RESUMED OUR LITIGATION IN THE TRIAL COURT WITH A GOAL OF BLOCKING THIS POLICY PERMANENTLY. ON THE LEGISLATIVE FRONT, WE CONTINUED OUR PARTNERSHIP WITH STATE-BASED ADVOCATES IN VARIOUS STATES, INCLUDING FLORIDA AND INDIANA, TO AMEND OR REPEAL DRACONIAN LAWS IMPOSING HARSHER PUNISHMENT ON SEXUAL ACTIVITY BY PEOPLE LIVING WITH HIV, AND AT THE FEDERAL LEVEL, WE CONTINUED OUR ADVOCACY TO UPDATE OUR NATION'S BLOOD DONATION POLICIES.
