TO EXPAND THE REACH AND SCALE OF ITS LITIGATION AND POLICY WORK, LEVERAGE THE EXPERTISE OF ITS INTERNAL SUBJECT MATTER EXPERTS, LAMBDA LEGAL RECRUITS, ORGANIZES AND OVERSEES THE WORK OF A LARGE NETWORK OF PRO BONO LAWYERS AND LAW FIRMS AROUND THE COUNTRY TO HELP IN OUR WORK. ASSEMBLING AND MANAGING THESE PRO BONO SERVICES IS A KEY COMPONENT OF OUR STRATEGY AND PROGRAM SERVICES. IT ALLOWS LAMBDA LEGAL TO EXPAND THE SCALE OF OUR ESSENTIAL, HIGH QUALITY LEGAL SERVICES NATIONWIDE WITH A MODEST STAFF, AND ENABLES US TO FOCUS OUR INTERNAL RESOURCES AS NEEDED TO A VARIETY OF BREAKING LEGAL ISSUES ACROSS THE COUNTRY. THIS WORK ALSO TRAINS AND EXPANDS THE POOL OF PRO BONO ATTORNEYS AVAILABLE AROUND THE COUNTRY TO ADVANCE THE WORK OF PROTECTING AND EXPANDING THE RIGHTS OF THE LGBTQ+ COMMUNITY ON AN ON-GOING BASIS.
